## **COLLEGE SPORT WELLINGTON INTER SECONDARY SCHOOL ARTISITIC**

**ROLLERSKATING CHAMPIONSHIP:** Our Open Competition will also host the inaugural College Sport Wellington Inter-Secondary School Championship giving those skaters at college in the Wellington region (Upper Hutt to Otaki) a chance to skate for their college. Entry is through the skater's school so college aged skaters, please see your sports coordinator and ask to enter these champs. You will skate the events as part of the normal UH Open Day competition – that is no extra events need to be skated - but two sets of results will be run from the events – one of them a specific college one. So you can skate the events you normally skate while representing your college. There will be certificates awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place getters in the College Competition as well as the prestigious CSW medal for the winner in each College event. Each event generates points for your school towards the top college title. For more details on grades offered and to enter, talk to the sports coordinator at your college who will have received information (it has been sent to them already) and an entry form. If they haven't, then please talk to Mary-Anne Thomson. Please enter this comp as it's a trial for this year and if there aren't enough people College Sport won't support it next year.

## **PATCH SKATERS MUST STAY SEATED UNTIL PATCH CLASS**

**STARTS:** There are three types of “card” a skater may be on –

1. a “full card” which entitles them to skate at any time unless the rink is booked for a private session,
2. a “part card” which entitles them to skate at patch class, public sessions run during the day and all of one nominated day a week, and
3. a “patch card” which entitles skating at patch class and daytime public sessions only.

Before Patch Class the only skaters entitled to be on the main rink **and the figures rink next to the seats** are those on a full card and those on a part card with their nominated day as Tuesday. All patch skaters **MUST** remain seated or at least in the carpet area until patch class starts. We appreciate you respecting those skaters who are entitled to skate by doing this. Anyone who wants to know more about moving to a part or full card can speak to the ladies on the desk.

**PLEASE RETURN CHOCOLATE AND LOLLY MONEY:** Thanks to all who have been selling chocolates and lollies to help club fundraising – we appreciate your efforts. **LOCAL LOWER MEDAL TESTS:** The club will be having medal tests at the club rink. Because of numbers already entered these will be on **Tuesday 3 & 10** (between 5.30 and 6.30pm) **Saturday 7 July** (2.00 – 3.00 pm) and **Friday 6 July** (10.30 am – 12.45 pm). These will be for medals 1 and 2 Figures, Freeskating and Dance only (no Precision). Anyone who thinks they may be interested in sitting these medals should discuss it with their coach now. **HIGHER MEDAL TESTS:** Higher medal tests (above medal 2 in Figures Freeskating and Dance and all Precision tests) will be held at Pascal Street Stadium Palmerston North on **August 4 and 5**. Skaters are reminded that anyone wanting to qualify for Oceania's 2013 must have the appropriate medal at the time nominations close so this test timing will be useful for those needing medals to nominate.

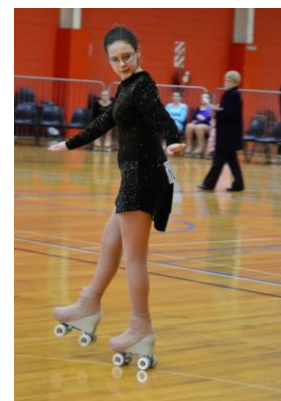
