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- (iii) Eligibility and qualifications for entry into the various grades are set out in the rules of the Artistic Sports Committee. Please ensure skaters are entered in the correct events.
- (iv) All skaters entering must be registered with the NZFRS and the Artistic committee, **and fulfill all qualifying requirements for their grade**, as at the closing date of entry for their Area Championships.
- (v) NZFRS Registrations for individuals and Club Affiliations will need to be renewed for 2021/2022 prior to competing in the New Zealand Championships.
- (vi) For **ALL** RollArt aligned grades programme content sheets must be submitted **to the Artistic Committee Secretary Janine Price on artistic.secretary@gmail.com by 20th May**. Programme sheets can be found on the World Skate website and included with this email.

2. ENTRY FEES

3. COACHES

- Have you registered as a Coach with the Federation? If you have, you will have floor and/or marshalling area privileges at New Zealand Championships.
- Only registered skaters and registered and accredited coaches and officials will be permitted in the marshalling area or on the floor, as required.
- Accredited coaches must wear their grey accreditation cards when needing to access the floor and marshalling area. If you don't have one please contact the Artistic Committee.
- Artistic Committee will appoint a supervisor to monitor the marshalling area credentials.
- Coaches must ensure that programme content sheets have been completed for their skaters and provided to the club secretary by the closing date of entries (**Thursday 20th May 2021**), when they are required.
- Coaches must have a back up copy of music available on USB in case of music failure.



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4. **MUSIC**

Music is to be received by the Chief Announcer no later than **20th June 2021**.

Music is to be submitted in mp3 format with **Event Name_Compétitor Name**.

It is the coaches'/skaters' responsibility to have a backup of the music on USB memory stick in case of music failure.

Any music collected for the 2021 Area Championships will be carried forward to the New Zealand Championships. Only re-send music if there have been alterations since the Area Championships.

Skaters who received dispensations and Club Show Challenge teams must email their music to nzartisticmusic@gmail.com by the above date.

Music certification required for Style Dance events must be submitted **with the entries**.
