COACHES: WORLD SKATE INTERNATIONAL ARTISTIC COACHING SCHOOL

We would like to clarify a few important points:

- 1. The World Skate International Seminar is open to ALL coaches, judges and for the first time, skaters who will participate at the practical classes at a rink.
- 2. The World Skate International Artistic Coaching School is open ONLY to the coaches nominated by the National Federations. Each coach needs to fulfil the criteria required to be nominated (previously sent). Please note that the decision to confirm a nominated coach to participate at the World Skate International Artistic Coaching School program will be solely up to World Skate. The deadline for the National Federations to send the name and the information requested of the coach/es to artistic@worldskate.org is November 30th 2018. Please note that up to three coaches will be accepted for those nations that for the vastness of the territory need more places to meet the requirements of the project. The Artistic Technical Commission will analyse each situation and will decide if to approve three coaches instead of two.
- 3. Coaches who participate at the 1st World Skate International Artistic Coaching School training program in Orlando will be provided with all technical and course information for each World Skate coach to train level 1 coaches in their country. At the end of the classes there will be an assessment just to check if all the information has been well transposed.
- 4. The World Skate International Artistic Coaching School project is a long-term plan to address coaching and skater's skills quality around the world. This process is expected to take at least 3 years to be fully functional.

SEMINAR - ENTRY FEES

The entry fee includes:

- 5 nights with breakfast included from Jan 10 to Jan 15, at the **Park Inn by Radisson Resort & Conference Centre Orlando**
- Hotel taxes
- Participation to the Seminar
- Teaching materials
- Certificate of participation
- Daily Shuttle Service to Disney Theme Park Attractions
- Resort Fee (Internet access in room and in all public areas of the hotel, daily USA Newspaper, 24-hour access to fitness and business centre, 2 outdoor heated pools and 1 large outdoor jacuzzi and daily shuttle service to Disney Theme Park Attractions)

SEMINAR - REGISTRATION / BOOKING

*Only seminar does not include accommodation.

TECHNICAL SPECIALISTS: INTERNATIONAL EXAMS

To get the title of **Technical Specialist/Controller** for the World Skate competitions in the chosen discipline/s, you must already be an international judge. The test will be ruled as follows:

- Written part. There will be 29 questions multiple choices. Between the 4 choices, one, two, three or all the four answers can be correct. To get to the practical test, the 80% of the answers must be correct. If the judge is already specialist in one of the disciplines, the questions will be 25, excluding code of ethics questions.

Questions will be based on the documents: "World Skate 2019 Rule books" (of the discipline/s chosen) and "World Skate General 2019".

- Practical part. The applicant will be asked to watch 2 videos (1 short program, 1 long program) and call the elements as if he/she was in a real panel. Even if the written part is good, if the judge fails the practical part he/she will not pass the test.

IMPORTANT:

The same international judge can apply for maximum two (2) disciplines.

For dance, the questions will be related to the pattern dances chosen for 2019 Junior and Senior Style Dances.

Written Part

- Unanswered questions will be counted as not correct.
- Some of the questions can require a free text answer.
- It is allowed 1 hour maximum for the written test.
- For those that want to apply to two disciplines there will be 25 questions more (technical on the second discipline) and it will be allowed 1:45 hours.

Practical Part

- The examinees must demonstrate sureness in the calling of the elements.
- For at least one of the two (2) videos the examinees must not do any mistake.
- For the other video maximum two (2) call errors will be accepted.



JUDGES: INTERNATIONAL EXAMS

To get the title of **World Skate International Judge**, for the World Skate competitions in the chosen discipline/s, the test will be ruled as follows:

- Written part. There will be 25 questions multiple choices. Between the 4 choices, one, two, three or all the four answers can be correct. To get to the practical test the 80% of the answers must be correct. If the judge is already international judge on one of the disciplines, the questions will be 20, excluding artistic impression questions.

Questions will be based on the documents: "World Skate 2019 Rulebooks" (of the discipline/s chosen), "World Skate General 2019" and "World Skate Artistic Impression".

- Practical part. The applicant will be asked to watch 2 videos (each for each discipline they are taking the test for) and give the score for Show and give QOE and Components for the other disciplines.

IMPORTANT:

The same judge can apply for maximum two (2) disciplines.

For dance, the questions will be related to the pattern dances chosen for 2019 Junior and Senior Style Dances.

Written Part

- Unanswered questions will be counted as not correct.
- Some of the questions can require a free text answer.
- It is allowed 1 hour maximum for the written test for International judges.
- For those that want to apply to two disciplines there will be 20 questions more (technical on the second discipline) and it will be allowed 1:45 hours.

Practical Part

- For Figures there will be not the practical part.
- The examinees must demonstrate sureness analyzing a program and in scoring with the old system (Show) and/or scoring QOE and Components.



- For both videos of each discipline chosen, the examinees must analyze and give good explanations for the QOEs and Components or the score (for Show).

STAGE FOR SKATERS: CLASSES

As previously communicated, for the first time at the International Artistic Skating Seminar, classes for all levels will be available for skaters for free skating, dance and pairs will take place.
